

ABOUT HUAXI VILLAGE





Huaxi village (华西村) is also called to be the No.1 Village of China. It is located in the east of **Jiangyin city**(江 阴, a county-level city directly administered by Wuxi Municipal Government) in Jiangsu Province. Huaxi village was established in 1961, is a model village in working for common prosperity, where modern industry and commerce and the rural enterprise were born and prospered. Huaxi Village has become a window for introducing people from China and abroad to China's countryside. Since the village was opened up to the outside world in 1994 nearly a million domestic and foreign tourists a year have been visiting and touring Huaxi Village and the villagers have been warmly serving them with traditional local dishes.



ABOUT YANGZHOU





Yangzhou, is a city with rich history of 2,500 years. As a prefecture jurisdiction, Yangzhou has a population of 4.6 million and a land mass of 6,634 square kilometers.

The city has been well known for its once brilliant historic role in Chinese history and one of the first 24 cities that were announced as the Historical and Cultural Cities in China. Until the 19th century, Yangzhou acted as a major national political, financial and trade center and a transport hub duo to its excellent location at the junction of the Yangtze, the Grand Canal and the Huaihe River. This historical period had left Yangzhou a large number of treasures, including valuable architectures and arts, splendid culture and the well-known Huaiyang cuisine.
